- Strengthen teacher capability in *knowing their learners* utilising data, curriculum and pedagogy to engage them in learning, as evidenced by learner progress.
- Provide learning environments and contexts that cater to the unique communication styles of every learner every day.
- Provide knowledgeable and confident communication partners for all learners, as evidenced by feedback and process utilising the Engagement Scales.
- Continue personalised student use of AAC systems across a range of communicative functions, with home/community relevancy and generalisation.

## Our initiatives include

- Developing Instructional Leadership capability and coaching culture.
- Strengthening school and teacher capability in data and assessment practices – Know Your Learner.
- Structuring time for in-depth staff discussions of learner data and strategies for continuously improving learner engagement in the areas of literacy and numeracy.
- Consolidating pedagogical practices and enhancing learning environments to support personalised literacy and numeracy learning.
- Implementing observation and feedback based on student engagement in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Creating environments that provide targeted, evidence-based communication support for all learners.
- Consolidating Process Based Learning project.


