Our initiatives include

- Development of our toolkit of evidence based, contemporary numeracy pedagogy
- Continue to provide additional SLP time to provide opportunities to enable all students to achieve their highest level of communication competence
- Engage consultants with specialised expertise in behaviour and play to build the capability of all staff towards facilitating opportunities to develop their personal and social capabilities
- Utilise regional and school-based coach support to reinvigorate and embed PB4L as a whole school initiative
- Local Indigenous languages incorporated in whole school curriculum implementation
- Continuing to develop community understanding and enactment of whole school wellbeing framework
- Realigning leadership team to maximise performance
